Philippians 1:9-10, "And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ"

Character: the qualities built into an individual's life that determine their responses, regardless of circumstances.

Initiative: Recognizing and doing what needs to be done before I am asked to do it

Derivation: The English word initiative came from the Latin verb initiare, which means "to begin; to originate."

Ini•tia•tive n 1: the power or ability to begin or to follow through with a plan or task 2: a beginning or introductory step; an opening 3: the lead

Weekly Verse: Proverbs 3:27 "Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in your power to act."

Bible Story: I Samuel 25 is the story of Abigail and her interactions with David.

Work

Anticipate what your employers expect from you, and exceed their expectations. Look for customers who need help or jobs that need to be done and get to work.

Home

Delight your family by finding ways to help around the house without being asked. Clean the kitchen, even when it is not your mess. Offer to help a younger sibling with schoolwork. When conflicts arise, take initiative to solve them quickly.
