Character Trait for May 7-11 is Security

Philippians 1:9-10, "And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ"

Character: the qualities built into an individual's life that determine their responses, regardless of circumstances.

Security: Structuring my life around that which cannot be destroyed or taken away

Derivation: late Middle English: from Old French securite or Latin securitas; 'free from care'

Weekly Verse: Proverbs 14:26 "Whoever fears the Lord has a secure fortress, and for their children it will be a refuge."

Bible Story: Matthew 7:24-29 tells the story of the man who built his house upon the rock.

Quote: "Security is knowing that God will never leave us or forsake us."
